



## FACT SHEET

**Q: What are the dates?**

A: Week 1 - 25<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> July inclusive and Week 2 - 8<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> August inclusive.

**Q: How many places are available?**

A: 250 places are available – 125 at each camp.

**Q: Where will the camp take place?**

A: The camp will take place at the Alnwick Town Football Club ground at St James's Park.

**Q: How much does it cost?**

A: Cost is £159 per child per week.

**Q: What is included in the cost?**

A: Each child will receive a full week's coaching and a full AC Milan football kit.

**Q: Who will be doing the coaching?**

A: Coaches and ex-players from AC Milan will be delivering the coaching. Coaches from Alnwick Town Juniors (Girls and Boys) will be assisting along with other local coaches.

**Q: How and when do I pay?**

A: Payment should be made by bank transfer; payment details will be sent to the email address you have registered with 1 week after registering. Payment **MUST** be made within 7 days of receiving this email. If you are concerned about payment, please contact a club official asap so that you don't miss out on this opportunity.

**Q: What happens if I miss the deadline for registration?**

A: You will still be able to register in a final pool released in early April.

**Q: What happens if I miss the payment deadline?**

A: Your place will be released and made available in the final pool released in early April – you can re-register in this pool.

**Q: What happens if there are more registrations than places?**

A: Places are strictly limited to 125 per camp. As soon as 125 payments for each camp have been received no further places will be allowed.

**Q: 5 children from each camp will be chosen to travel to Milan to train with the squad and watch a match in the San Siro stadium – who will make this decision?**

A: Only the coaches from AC Milan will make this decision with no outside influence from parents/players or club officials.

**Q: Will there be any presentation ceremonies during the camps?**

A: There will be presentations on the last day of each camp (29<sup>th</sup> July and 12<sup>th</sup> August) and food afterwards.
