Managers code of conduct

1. Be reasonable in your demands on children's time, energy and enthusiasm.
2. Never ridicule or shout at the children for making mistakes or losing a match.
3. Never shout at or abuse match officials.
4. Shouting from the sidelines should always be discouraged apart from general encouragement.
5. Teach players that the Laws of the Game are mutual agreements that should never be broken.
6. Develop respect for the ability of opponents as well as the judgement of the officials and opposing coaches.
7. Set good standards of behaviour yourself and always offer praise and encouragement and try to have as much one to one communication with your players as possible.
