- 4. Maintain an effective organisational structure, including committees, that will best promote the interests of its members
- 5. Establish a positive profile within the local community and a reputation for competitive play, good facilities and sportsmanship amongst its opponents at all levels
- 6. Create and promote a sense of club and team identity through good communication
- 7. Maintain cordial and open relationships with appropriate governing bodies and other relevant agencies
- 8. Extend a welcome to those in the Geddington area who wish to participate in cricket and related activities
- 9. Ensure that all team selection and associated processes are undertaken in a timely, fair and transparent way
- 10. Support, where appropriate, those of its members that may wish to develop skills, such as coaching, that promote the club's goals
