## HAVERHILL ROVERS FOOTBALL CLUB ADDITIONAL RULES

(to be read in conjunction with the RESPECT Code of Conduct)

### Haverhill Rovers Youth agree to:

- Provide a match kit (shirt, shorts, socks) as a minimum if a sponsor cannot be sourced. This kit remains the property of the club and should only be used for the purpose supplied
- Provide adequate training equipment for weekly sessions to be delivered (balls, bibs, cones etc)
- Provide a safe environment for training sessions and matches (3G or grass pitch)
- Provide weekly training sessions with suitably qualified coaches and matches for a football season, unless conditions outside of our control prevent that i.e. adverse weather conditions
- To ensure sufficient insurance is in place as required by the County FA
- To provide access to a Welfare Officer

#### Players agree to:

- Turn up to all training sessions on time, unless advised to the manager in advance
- Attend all matches both home and away, unless advised to the manager in advance
- Follow the Club's Code of Conduct
- Not to speak to other Clubs without permission from the manager or committee members
- Not to publish any results, or means to indicate a result, for any matches up to and including U11 teams using any avenue of communication, including social media
- Not to make any comments on social networking sites which is deemed offensive, threatening, violent, discriminatory or that brings the game into disrepute. I understand that Haverhill Rovers Football Club reserves the right to exclude any player, parent(s) or representative of that individual should this occur. This could also lead to charges being brought by the County FA if reported

### Parents/Carers agree to:

- Ensure that your child(ren) attend training on time and are collected at the end of each session
- Ensure that your child is available for matches at whatever time and location is agreed with the manager
- Ensure fees are paid when they become due directly to the club treasurer
- Ensure that any player fines incurred whilst playing in matches are settled within 14 days of the match in which it occurred, non-payment will mean player will be suspended from play until settled











- Allow the player to take responsibility for his/her own equipment, ie water bottles, shin pads, suncream, etc to aid their development, making decisions for themselves helps them make decisions on the pitch
- Not to speak to other clubs without permission from the manager or committee members
- Not to publish any results, or means to indicate a result, for any matches up to and including U11 teams using any avenue of communication including social media
- Not to make any comments on social networking sites which is deemed offensive, threatening, violent, discriminatory or that brings the game into disrepute, I understand that Haverhill Rovers Football Club reserves the right to exclude any player, parents or representative of that individual should this occur. This could also lead to charges being brought by the County FA if reported
- Follow the Club's Code of Conduct for Supporters, Parents and Carers and ensure you are a good example to all the players
- Ensure that the club is notified immediately of any personal data that needs to be updated to ensure the club holds accurate records in line with the GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation)
- Notify your child's team manager and club secretary if your child intends to leave the club so your child's records are updated on the club database
- Arrange for the immediate return of any kit or equipment supplied by Haverhill Rovers F C (the club) should your child leave
- Accept that failure to return kit/equipment if my child leaves will give the club the right to invoice me for the cost of replacement items
